He shares his vocal talent at a variety of churches in the MD and DC areas but enjoys serving as a cantor, member of the choir and occasional choir director at his church, St. Paul's Moravian Church in Upper Marlboro, MD. He tends to thrive best in the genres of Musical Theatre, Opera, and Spiritual Music. He is inspired by Luciano Pavarotti, Andrea Bocelli, Placido Domingo and Jonas Kaufman. John has been given the gift of music which is truly his passion in life.
